



CSA Weather and Field Closure Policy

CSA Field Closures follows Calvert County Parks & Recreation (CCPR) field closures unless we cancel any usage prior to them. If CCPR closes a field at any of the county parks, satellite, or school fields and a team is scheduled to use it, this means the practice, training, and/or game is canceled.

You can get up to date CCPR field closures by calling the CCPR weather hotline (410-535-1600 ext 2640), checking their website, or FaceBook page. We will try to post closures as soon as we are notified on our website and Facebook page for all fields throughout Calvert County.

CSA practices, trainings, and/or games should be delayed by 20-30 minutes at the first presence of lightning and/or thunder and each presence after before resuming activities. All players, parents/families, and coaches should leave the field immediately and take shelter.

CSA also follows a temperature policy even if CCPR does not close fields. CSA uses Accuweather (Prince Frederick, MD location) as the weather source to make the following decisions on when to cancel CSA OUTDOOR trainings/practices due to temperature:

- If the “Real Feel” is 32 degrees or lower
- If the “Real Feel” is 100 degrees or higher
