## CSA Calvert Cup Tournament

The Calvert Cup Tournament will use the Single Elimination Bracket format. Tournament games are usually held on Saturday and/or Sunday. The "Home" team is at the bottom of the bracket and will wear yellow/gold jerseys during the game. The "Away" team (opponent) will wear their black/gray jersey during the game. All players must bring both jerseys to all tournament games.

- U6 - 12 minute halves (3 minute half time break)
- U7 \& U8 - 20 minute halves (3 minute half time break)
- U9/10 - 20 minute halves (3 minute half time break)
- U11/12 - 25 minute halves (5 minute half time break)
- U13/14 - $\quad 30$ minute halves ( 5 minute half time break)
- U15+/HS - 30 minute halves (5 minute half time break)


## Tournament Awards:

U6 - U8 Divisions - Finalists receive Silver Medals; Champions receive Gold Medals U9 - U14 Divisions - Finalists receive Silver Medals; Champions receive Trophies.
HS Division - Gift Cards will be given to the Champions and Finalists.

## End of Season Awards:

U6 - U8 Divisions - All receive participation medals
U10-HS Divisions - Season Champions receive Gold Medals
Tie Breaker "Overtime" Rules (applies to all tournament games):
Golden Goal is in effect for all tie breaker games- first team to score wins.
Reduced team concept: At the conclusion of the game, the team size is reduced, and goalkeeper positions are eliminated.

Teams will be reduced to:
11 v 11 divisions will play 5 v 5
9 v 9 divisions will play 4 v 4
7 v 7 divisions will play 3 v 3
5 v 5 division will play 3 v 3
4 v 4 divisions will play 4 v 4
In Overtime if a penalty kick is awarded then a goalkeeper will be used to defend the goal. The ball is not playable after the penalty kick has been taken (after goal, out of bounds or touched by keeper). If the kick is not successful then the goalkeeper will be removed and the game will resume play.

Only players on the field at the end of regulation time may stay on the field for the first overtime including the goalie. If the game is still tied after 5 minutes, the referee will stop play for substitutions. All players on the field must be substituted if the team has enough players. If after 5 additional minutes and the game is still tied, the referee will stop again for substitution. Players that remained from the first substitution must be substituted and players from bench that have not played in overtime must be used until all players have played at least one overtime period. Game will be restarted with either a drop kick at place play was stopped or appropriate restart if play was stopped during a natural stoppage.

All referee decisions are final. Protests are not permitted.
